<p>EMERGENCY AID COALITION (EAC) was founded in 1983 and each year helps more than 50,000 individuals living on the edge of poverty. The EAC often helps those who must choose between paying the rent and feeding the family. Multiple congregations are collaborating to provide temporary assistance with an emphasis on serving the working poor. EAC provides food, clothing, sack lunches 6 days a week, school uniforms and school supplies with the goal of assisting clients working toward self-sufficiency.
